

Distracted or Inattentive Crash Stats Louisiana



On average, from 2020-2024, there were 176 fatalities and 817 suspected serious injuries per year.



28% increase in Louisiana distracted or inattentive fatal driving crashes in 2024 from 2020.



Drivers between the ages of 25-34 have the highest number of fatalities resulting from distracted or inattentive driving.

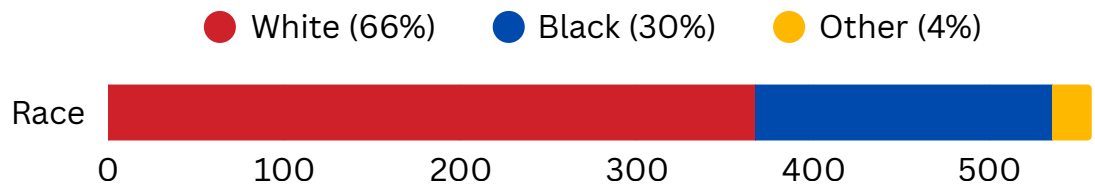


210 passengers died in a distracted or inattentive driving crash from 2020-2024.

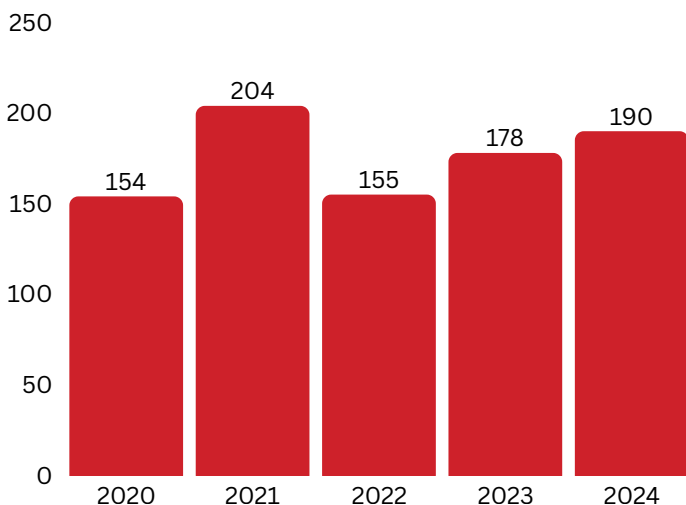


72% of Louisiana drivers killed in a distracted or inattentive driving crash from 2020-2024 were male.

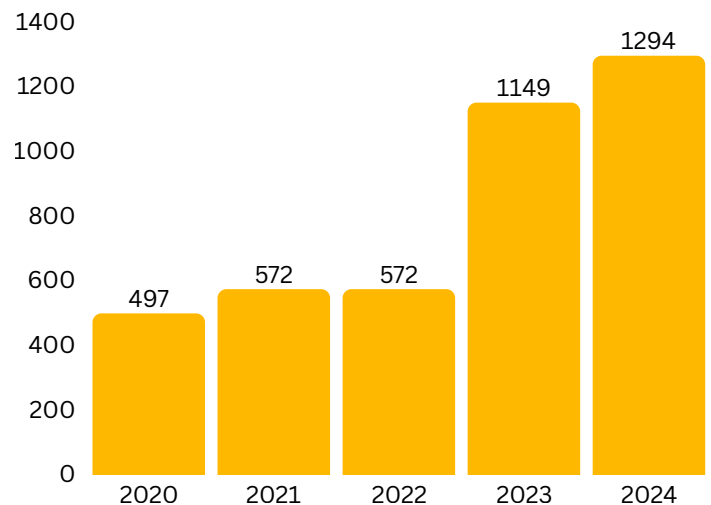
Distracted or Inattentive Driver Crash Fatalities By Race
